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#### Introduction

This instruction guide is for people ages 10+ who are interested in building the Reindeer and Sleigh design from Lego™ in the Lego™ Digital Designer Software or with physical bricks! A concise guide to how to build this set will be provided for both newcomers and builders with past experience. This manual will address broad questions about the general building process for new builders, as well as specific piece instructions for experienced builders. If you're a new builder, this manual will help you to build your design in about 1 hour and 30 minutes. If you're an experienced builder, this manual will help you to build your design in about 1 hour.

As the builder, you have the freedom to add or remove pieces to the model as you create to make it your own! Lego™ encourages your exploration of your imagination. Should the Reindeer be a different color? Or would you want to add snow flakes on the Sleigh? Or maybe you want to add your own, original Santa Claus. The options are endless with the Lego™ Digital Designer Software or using physical bricks!

This set includes 214 pieces in total, which are individually labelled and assigned to either the Sleigh (S) or Reindeer (R). Specifics on piece labeling can be found on the following page. #### **Instructions for Building**

#### **Instructions for the Reindeer**

	Steps	Pieces	Illustration
1.	Take <b>10x</b> of <b>R6</b> and attach them to <b>R10</b> so that there are five on each side and a gap on <b>R10</b> . In the gap on <b>R10</b> , place <b>1x</b> of <b>R4</b> so that the middle two knobs fit over the knobs of <b>R10</b> .	R4 1x R6 10x R10 1x	
4.	Use 2x of R2 and attach them to the bottom of R4 on either side of R10.  Attach 1x of R3 to the top of R4 so that it covers the middle two knobs of R4.  Use 2x of R5 and connect the lower portion of each piece to R4 and the upper portion of each piece to R3.	R2 2x R3 1x R5 2x	

<ul> <li>6. Use 2x of R26 and 2x of R1. Slide one piece of R1 onto one end of each piece R26.</li> <li>7. Slide 1x of R26 through the hole of each R2 piece that is connected to R4, until each R2 piece touches the R1 pieces already on R26.</li> <li>8. Slide 1x of the remaining R1 pieces onto each R26 piece, leaving a large space between these R1</li> </ul>	<b>©</b> R1 2x	
pieces and the R2 pieces that are already on the R26 pieces.  TIP: Instead of yellow R1 pieces, you can make them white like snowflakes!	R26 2x	
<ol> <li>Repeat Steps 1-5 with the remaining R10, R6, R4, R2, and R3 to create the back of the second reindeer.</li> <li>Slide 1x of newly connected R2 piece onto each R26 piece on the outside of the R1 pieces from Step 8.</li> </ol>		
<ol> <li>Use 4x of R7 and 8x of R8. Stack 2x of R8 on top of each R7 piece to create the reindeer legs.</li> <li>Attach 1x of R9 to the top pieces of R8. The R8 pieces should be connected to the corners of the R9 piece so that it looks like a table.</li> <li>Use 2x of R25 and attach them to R9. The R25 pieces should cover the two middle pegs on the short sides of R9 and be positioned so that the slanted end is on bottom and faces outward.</li> <li>Place 2x of R11 pieces on the R9 piece. They should be positioned on either side of the R25 pieces so that R11 covers the entire length of R9 on each side.</li> </ol>	R7 4x  R8 8x  R9 1x  R25 2x	
TIP: You can make your Reindeer spotted by replacing some of the R25 brown pieces with white or black	R11 2x

<ul> <li>15. Use 1x of R9 piece and place it on top of the R25 and R11 pieces. The lines of this R9 piece should line up with the R9 piece from Step 12.</li> <li>16. Attach 1x of R12 piece to one of the R25 pieces from Step 13.</li> <li>17. Attach 1x of R16 piece to the R12 piece so that angled side faces downward and the pointed edge is directed outward.</li> <li>18. Place 1x of R24 piece on top of the R16 piece so the entire top side of R16 is covered by R24.</li> </ul>	R9 1x  R12 1x  R16 1x  R24 1x	
<ol> <li>19. Attach 1x of R25 piece to the other R25 piece that is partially exposed so that the angled side faces down and outward.</li> <li>20. Place 1x of R21 piece on the newest R25 addition, and place x1 of R25 on the exposed section of the last R25 piece mentioned.</li> <li>21. Attach 1x of R19 piece to the top of the R21 and the R25 that were added in Step 20.</li> <li>22. Attach 1x of R25 to the top of the partially exposed R25 piece added in Step 20. The angled side should face down and outward.</li> </ol>	R19 1x R21 1x R25 3x	
<ul> <li>23. Place 1x of R14 piece on top of the R19 and the R25 from Steps 21 and 22, respectively. The excess of R14 should be placed on the outside and not toward the body of the reindeer.</li> <li>24. Use 6x of R13 pieces. Attach them to the top of the R14 piece in two rows of three with the side knobs facing outward to either side of R14.</li> </ul>	R13 6x R14 1x	

<ul> <li>25. Use 2x of R17 pieces. Attach them to the R13 pieces closest to the body of the reindeer so that they are vertical, with the lowest peg connected to the R13 pieces.</li> <li>26. Attach 1x of R18 piece to each of the R17 pieces from Step 25. They should be placed at the bottom of the R17 pieces, on the other side from the R14 pieces from Step 23.</li> <li>27. Connect 1x of R18 piece to 1x of R23 piece to each R17 piece. One peg of the R23 piece should connect to the middle of each R17 piece, and the other peg should attach to an R18 piece that is placed in the direction of the reindeer's body on either side.</li> <li>28. Repeat Steps 25 – 27 to make the other antler.</li> <li>TIP: You can make the antlers longer by attaching more R17, R18, and R23 pieces together!</li> </ul>	R17 2x R18 1x R23 1x	
<ul> <li>29. Place 1x of R18 piece at the top of each R17 piece from Step 25.</li> <li>TIP: You can exchange one of the R22 pieces for a red one and make Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer!</li> <li>30. Use 4x of R22 pieces. Attach 1x of R22 to the tops of the R13 pieces that are in between the two R17 pieces. Attach 1x of R22 to each side of the R13 pieces immediately in front of those connected to the R17 pieces. Attach the fourth R22 to the two pegs exposed on the R14 piece from Step 23.</li> <li>31. Attach 1x of R15 piece to the four remaining pegs on top of the reindeer's head, belonging to four of the R13 pieces from Step 24.</li> <li>32. Attach 1x of R20 piece to each of the two remaining knobs on the R13 pieces from Step 24. These will be the reindeer's' eyes.</li> </ul>	R15 1x  R18 1x  R22 4x  R20 2x	

33. Attach the body of the reindeer to the curved back that was created in **Steps 1-5** and attached to the harness in **Step 7**.



34. Repeat **Steps 1-33** with the remaining reindeer pieces to create the second reindeer.



TIP: You can make even more reindeer by simply repeating Steps 1-33!

## Instructions for the Sleigh

Steps	Pieces	Illustrations
<ol> <li>Begin with 1x of S9. Take 1x of S7 and place it on the top of the pointed end of S9.</li> <li>Take 1x of S2 and place it next to S7.</li> <li>Take 1x of S8 and place it on top of S9, next to S2.</li> <li>Take 1x of S2 and place it on top of S9, directly next to S8.</li> <li>Take 1x of S7 and place it on the remaining space above S9.</li> <li>Repeat Steps 1-5 to make a replica of the other sleigh runner.</li> </ol>	S2 2x S7 2x S8 1x S9 1x	
<ol> <li>7. Take 4x of \$6. Place 3 of them directly in the middle of \$10. Take the remaining piece of \$6 and place half of it on \$10.</li> <li>8. Take 1x of \$3 and place it underneath \$6, so it is in line with \$10.</li> <li>9. Take 3x of \$21 and attach each one on top of \$10.</li> <li>TIP: You can change the color of the Sleigh by using different colored Legos!</li> </ol>	S3 1x S6 4x S10 1x S21 3x	
<ul> <li>10. Take 1x of S4 and attach it to the pointed end of S21.</li> <li>11. Take 2x of S15 and place them on top of S10, directly in front of 3x of S21.</li> <li>12. Take 2x of S20 and place them on top of S10,</li> </ul>	S4 1x

13. Take 2x of S16 and place them directly in front of S15.	S6 2x

15. Take <b>2x</b> of <b>S23</b> and place them on top of the remaining space of the <b>S21</b> pieces, between the two <b>S15</b> pieces.	S12 2x	
<ul> <li>16. Take 2x of S12 and place each on the top of the S16 pieces.</li> <li>17. Take 1x of S11 and place it directly on top and on the center of S5 so that a singular space remains empty on either side of S11.</li> </ul>	S16 4x	
<ul> <li>18. Take 2x of S6 and fill the remaining singular space on either side of S11.</li> <li>19. Take 3x of S22 and place them along the tops of S6 and S11.</li> </ul>	S22 3x	
<ul><li>20. Place 3x of S18 and place them along the top of S3.</li><li>21. Place 3x of S19 along the middle of S18.</li></ul>	S18 3x

<ul> <li>22. Place 3x of S21 along the top of the slanted end of S18.</li> <li>23. Place 2x of S14 on the remaining visible parts of S10 and S3.</li> <li>24. Take 2x of S12 and place each of them on S14 so that they are next to S20.</li> <li>25. Take 2x of S17 and place them between S14 on the remaining spaces of S18.</li> </ul>	S12 2x S14 2x S17 2x S21 3x	
<ul> <li>26. Take 2x of S19 and place them on the outsides edges of S21, directly behind S14.</li> <li>27. Place S11 along the back of S21.</li> <li>28. Place S13 in the remaining space in front of S11.</li> <li>TIP: We suggest adding an animal companion to your Sleigh! In your Lego™ Digital Designer you can search for any animal to add.</li> </ul>	S11 1x S13 1x S19 2x	
<ul> <li>29. Place S1 on top of S19, directly behind S14, so that there is no space between those two pieces.</li> <li>30. Take 2x of S20 and place them so they are covering the top of both S14 and S1.</li> <li>31. Place S5 on the remaining parts of S19.</li> <li>32. Place S23 directly in the center of S5.</li> <li>33. Take 2x of S24. Place one on either side of S23.</li> <li>34. Take 2x of S12. Place one on either side of S12.</li> <li>35. Attach the sleigh runners to the bottom of the</li> </ul>	S1 1x S5 2x S12 2x

36. To connect your Reindeer and Sleigh, simply connect the 2x of R26 to the knobs of the 2x of S6.
